**MEMORANDUM FOR DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF, RESEARCH  
AND DEVELOPMENT**

I have considered your attached proposal (alternative #3) for the realignment of responsibilities for the SR-71 and YF-12A programs. In general, I approve your concept; however, Colonel Geary, as Assistant for Special Programs must continue to be directly responsible to me. I am convinced that this relationship must continue until the SR-71 program transitions into an operational system status.

I do not wish to imply any lack of concern for your interests and responsibilities in these activities. On the contrary, you must continue to become more familiar with the details of these programs. In view of the impending transition to an operational force of the SR-71 program, I intend to have an early review of the SR-71 program, emphasizing these aspects of planning and programming which bear directly on the efficient creation of the operational SR-71 unit at Beale AFB next year. I have asked Colonel Geary to present this review on 20 November.

It is my intention that you participate directly in this review and that proper representation by SAC also be included. My instructions to Colonel Geary on this subject are contained in the attached memorandum.

After you have worked out the implementing details of the organizational alignment, I would appreciate reviewing the final arrangement and obtain your thoughts on any further action you feel may contribute to the effectiveness of the program.

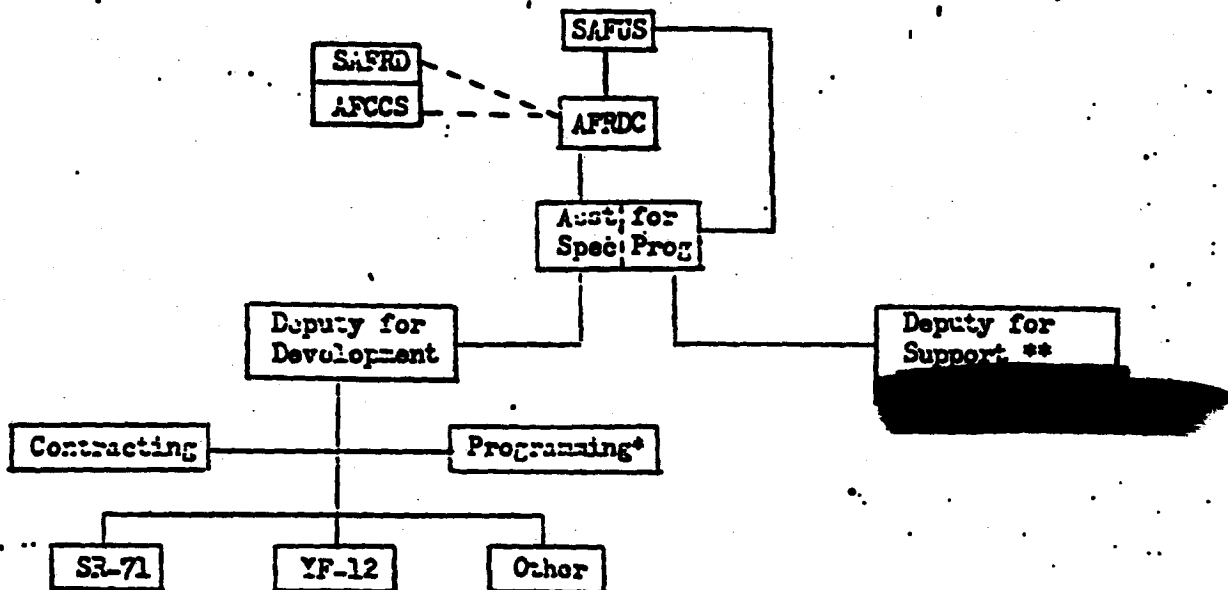

**Alternative #3**

1. Assign Program Director to RDC for all development matters
2. Establish SR-71/YF-12 office
3. [REDACTED]
4. Program Director remains responsible for Support, existing procedures
5. Use extension of present office facilities
6. [REDACTED]



**Pros:** Provides overt office  
 Program Director in RDC  
 More efficient manning (cross utilization)  
 Uses existing secure facilities  
 Starting point for later split

**Cons:** Admin complicated (two staff units)  
 Orders, travel funds, etc.  
 ER situation difficult  
 RDC cannot evaluate total job of Asst  
 Asst reports to two masters (SAFUS - RDC)  
 SAFUS relinquishes direct channel to Program Director.
