


Attached is the letter which I worked out with John Walsh on interference with SALT national technical means. As you will recall, General Allen called me to see if we would be able to institute.




SUBJECT: Compliance with SAL Agreements (U)

-(6) Your attention is directed to Section IV of the attachment to DoD Instruction S-5100.72 which states, in part: "...any action or measure taken or to be taken under any project or program, whether currently in force or proposed, which reasonably raises the possibility of causing...interference to Soviet technical means of verification shall be submitted to DDR&E for ... prior review..."
