- 1. Purpose: This statement of work defines authorized and funded actions in support of POPPY. References (a) and (b) are tasking documents to NRL and NSG (G-54) respectively.
- 2. Objective: The objective is to continue POPPY operations support as long as the satellites are producing useful data, and to make an orderly transition in accordance with reference (c).
- 3. Concept: POPPY is an NRP resource that receives direction for ELINT collection from the USIB as the requirements authority. Director, Program C is the NRO designated manager for all aspects of planning, programming, budgeting, financial control, procurement, engineering, test and logistic support. The NRL and the NSG are the principle organizations through which POPPY is operated and supported. NRP funds are provided to supplement standard operational funding and to purchase engineering and logistic services not otherwise available. This PGD sets forth the planned disposition of POPPY resources for FY 74.
- 4. Cancellation: This document remains in force until specifically amended or cancelled by the POPPY System Project Officer.
