Subj: Satallite experiment; costs of

- 1. Current reapproise of the funds required to conduct the satellite experiment under the cognisance of BUV-EPS (BUORD task \$13942/2001)/97371 and BUAER project NRL-AV-42004) indicates that the fiscal year 1980 coats will be approximately \$793,000. Funds on hand at NRL for these fiscal year 1980 costs now total \$568,000, including \$50,000 each from BUV-EPS (BUORD). ONR and NRL as egreed in a meeting attended by representatives of CNO, BUV-EPS, and NRL on 2 December 1959. The funds on hand have now been exhausted. A total of \$225,000 to continue the project during tiscal year 1960 is required. However, if as egreed in the meeting mentioned above, the \$50,000 in new funds are received from BUV-EPS (BUAER), \$175,000 will then be required for fiscal year 1960. It is requested that these funds be furnished in order that the project may be continued.
- 2. If the experiment is successful, data reduction costs to the extent of \$20,000 will be incurred in fiscal year 1861. If the leanching is delayed beyond 15 June 1960 additional fiscal year 1961 costs will be involved. These costs will be determined when the contingency is experienced and uncertainties are resolved.
- 5. Members of the staff of NRL will be available should BUT EPS desire to discuss this matter.
