MEMORANDUM

Subj: Visit to ELINT Sites by H. O. Lorenzen and R. D. Mayo

- 1. The subject personnel visited the ELINT Sites to be utilized in project GREB. The main purpose of the visits was to inform each Station's Commanding Officer of the project so he could anticipate the planning required in integrating it into the station's operational plan, to provide for training and to resolve any logistic problems, such as; establishing the local ability to handle the hut when it arrives, locate a mutually agreeable spot to place the hut and select a proper source of electrical power.
- 2. Complete briefings were given to the Commanding Officer and those officers whom he felt should have the information to effectively support the operation. Briefings on only the cover experiment were given to additional station operational and material personnel as the Commander felt it desirable to stimulate interest and to generate support for this type project. Since the techniques were unusual and unique it was felt that key personnel were needed to generate a healthy interest in the subject. All the briefings were received enthusiastically and with a desire to participate.
