1. The subject contract, covering one (1) Prototype and five (5) production equipments, requires test and approval of the Prototype equipment by NRL for compliance with the requirements of the governing specifications prior to release of production.
2. The Prototype equipment was delivered to NRL by [redacted] ITT Laboratory's Project Engineer, on 1 April 1959, and was subjected to the required tests and rejected by reference (a). The basic cause for rejection was its failure to meet the paramount requirement for over-all System sensitivity. This was isolated as resulting from imperfections in the Acceptance Band characteristics of the six Filter-Crystal units which form a part of each System, both individually and as matched sets. These were returned to the contractor for investigation and further work. The other units of the Prototype, namely the Antennas and Amplifiers were retained at the Laboratory inasmuch as they appeared to be satisfactory.
3. On 26 May 1959 these Filter-Crystal units were resubmitted to the Laboratory by [redacted]. Subsequent tests of the Prototype System with these units indicated that the governing specifications were now met and that satisfactory performance could be obtained. The ITT Laboratories were so advised through [redacted] by a long distance phone call on 2 June 1959, and that production would be officially released by correspondence.
4. The Laboratory had hoped that it might be possible to devise a simplified method of testing the production equipments but experimental investigation has indicated that it will probably be necessary to conduct acceptance tests on the assembled Systems in accordance with the performance requirements of the specifications.
