

The program has:

- 1. Provided meaningful guidance for the Electronic Warfare programs of the three services.
- 2. Confirmed the major electronics threats.
- 3. Provided an index of electronic frequency use in all Sino-Soviet Bloc countries.
- 4. Provided a pattern of electronic employment around-the-clock and day-by-day.
- 5. Identified the major electronic threats as differentiated from the defensive radar systems.
- 6. Provided hemisphere-wide coverage daily.
- 7. Due to long life of certain systems, provided the same yardstick of performance daily.
- 8. Confirmed every major emitter identified by any other source.
- 9. Provided coverage in the interior not previously possible.
- 10. Avoided needless expenditure to counter postulated systems which do not exist.
- ll. Provided a meaningful product the validity of which cannot be challenged.
- 12. Provided true data for radar order of battle.
- 13. Provided long enough surveillance to observe changes in emitter performance.
- 14. Produced data more accurate than is available by most other techniques.
