INFORMATION TO BE INCLUDED ON "COMMON-LANGUAGE" DIGITAL DATA TAPES

- 1. Physical medium and coding not specified
- 2. All tapes to state a reference year, day, time Other time groups to be relative to this Exact format to be decided Friday
- 3. All tapes to carry a serial number which identifies method used to extract data. Serial numbers to be issued by a single agency to be selected Friday. All parties receiving a serial number shall state the reliability associated with this process.
- 4. Means shall be provided to identify the receiving site that produced blocks of data. This need not be repeated for every data point. Exact method to be finalized Friday.
- 5. Data points to include for each burst one or more of the following sets (which set implied by serial #).
 - a. Time of center burst, prf
 - b. Time of beginning of burst, prf (not favored)
 - c. Time beginning, duration, prf
 - d. Time of beginning, number of pulses, prf
 - e. Additional formats to be added Friday (possibly including S/N ratio
