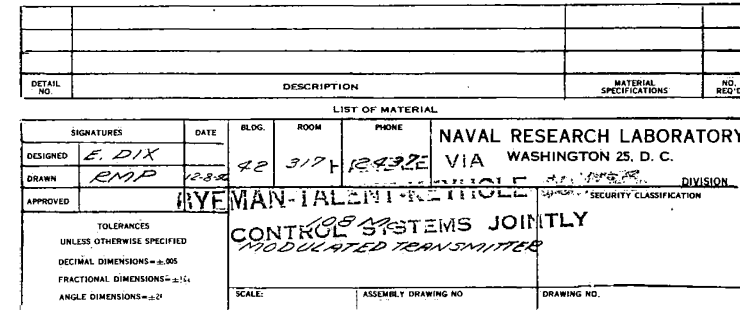


LIKE THE OTHER SATELLITES IN THE VANGUARD SERIES, VANGUARD 2 WAS PLACED  
IN ORBIT BY THE NRL-DEVELOPED VANGUARD LAUNCH VEHICLE.



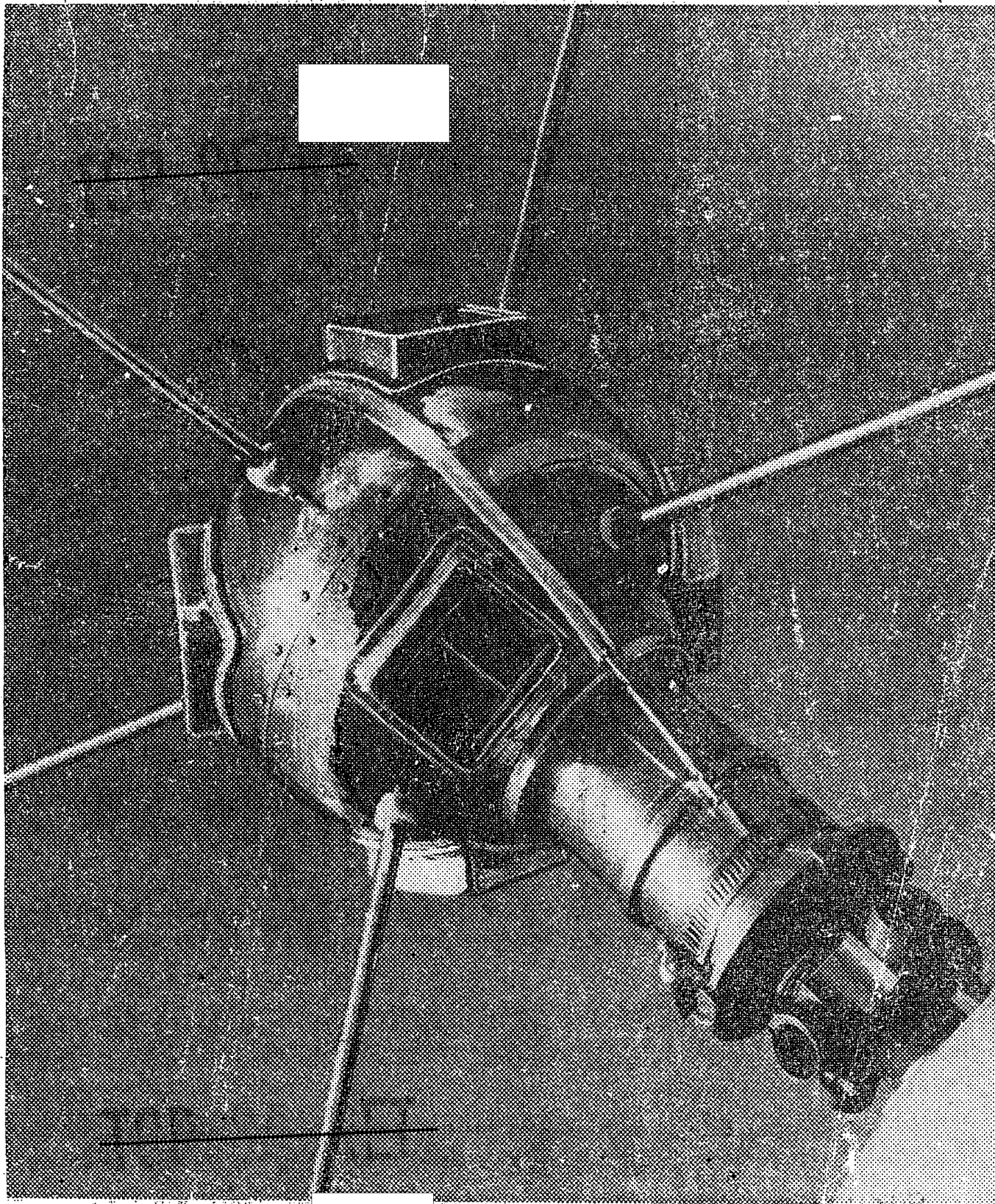
