Admiral MOORER asked why he had not been approached for help in gaining approval to place this capability in the Said "Lets get this out of the nickel seats" and put an "Old Grandad" label on it. He is most anxious for this one to get installed and operational.

MOORER, MORAN, COOKE, MOFFIT and AURAND all had inputs in the politics of the situation with MORAN assuring Admiral MOORER that under the circumstances if there was any real problems Admiral MOORER would have been approached. Admiral MOORER asked who was running the show toward getting this operational and MOFFIT said that Admiral HARLFINGER was. Admiral MOORER asked if there was a program funded and underway and MOFFIT said yes sir! COOKE said that his people were preparing a proposal for impleminting the operational scene on this one. Admiral MORAN was, if anything, pretty negative about there being any problems that progress was going about as fast as one could expect and that everything was on track and under control.

By the way Admiral MORAN called me the afternoon before Admiral MOORER's visit to get the agenda and to re=assure me that our agenda seemed to fill the bill. He said that Admiral MOORER came aboard on these things fast and not to repeat.


