1. Installation of Receiving and Quality Control Instrumentation at [redacted] is scheduled to leave NRL on or about mid May 1967 for installation at site by NRL team during July 1967. All collection sites are destined to have complete A-to-D data conversion and new recording systems early in 1968, but require operations be moved from Huts into permanent quarters indoors.
2. There is no plan to provide "on-line" operations of equipment as a substitute for basic human intelligence, to preclude tracking the wrong signal. Careful adherence to the Standard Operations Procedure concerning the pre-pass preparation of an Azimuth versus Time Chart will work adequately as it does for the other sites in avoiding the loss of data.
3. The Naval Research Laboratory will continue to support this program by implementation of the latest and best instrumentation and techniques for the field collection of data. These matters are best taken up at the Steering Committee (TOG) meetings rather than via the dispatch routes due to the critical demands which are on the NRL team at this time.
