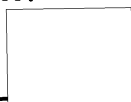

This office provides the leadership in the Navy for space programs and provides the interface with the National Reconnaissance Program Office. It acts as the focal point for the design, concept formulation and operational support for Navy Program (C). Assures the assets for support are provided and the approved programs have realistic support. Coordinates with NSG to assure the National SIGINT resources are allocated to assure successful prosecution of the program. Works with NRL to assure the most effective satellite designs are proposed to support Program C. Insures the engineering development to implement the systems concepts in space and at the readout at the ground stations is effected. Provides the stimulus for new and broader concepts in future system planning. Provides the proper fiscal and operational reviews to assure a healthy and progressive program is planned and in being.


NSG provides the Director and the Navy with all the elements of support to assure present and future programs in the field are successful. Plans for and provides all operational housekeeping, operational data taking, data reduction and communication problems are properly met and planned for. Acts as an interface between the National Security Agency (NSA) operations and the program and assures that the resources required are allocated to the program. Acts as the main interface for passing processed data to the operational Navy and to NSA.

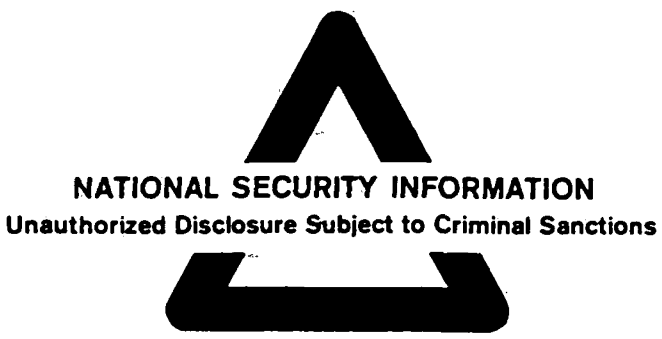
