Reference b identified that against the net additional funding of \$1,316.3, Navy FY 72 W 4418 would provide \$1,100.0, and the NRO was requested to provide \$216.3. Revised approvals are on this basis.

Reference b also identified a long lead time item for Software Competitive Study at \$2,000K, to be funded from Navy FY 72 W 4418, but reference c indicates that CHARGE contracting may apply, and required funding is to be determined. Accordingly, approval for software competitive studies is withheld pending these determinations.

With respect to the <u>financing</u> of approvals, you are authorized to use the \$1,100K from Navy FY 72 W 4418 availabilities directly, without transmittal to the Air Force and retransmittal to your office, and to use the reprogrammed NRO availabilities. The additional \$216.3K from NRO will not be issued at this time, pending the software determinations.

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

SUBJECT: FY 1973 Financial Program, FY 1974 Budget, and FY 1975 thru 1978 Planning

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- C. Cost estimates for each of FY 1973 and 1974 are to distinguish between:
- 1. Payload-related costs as separately-identified by applicable vehicle, and by appropriate line items (Command/Control, Telemetry, etc.).
- 2. Ground station development/investment costs, as related to individual stations wherever possible, but excluding processing development or equipment.
- 3. Ground station operating costs, separately identifying combined costs for supporting existing equipments at current ground stations and costs for supporting proposed new or replacement equipments.
 - 4. Facilities (Investment) costs, by line item.
 - 5. Services (Operational) costs, by line item.
- 6. In each preceding instance, provide pertinent explanations, particularly where costs vary from FY 1972 current approvals.
- D. As a separate identification, with an extract copy to be sent to NSA for appropriate action, submit recommendations for ground station development/investment as directly related to processing equipments. It is expected that NSA will budget and fund for these costs, rather than the NRP, altho certain specific determinations may be necessary.
- E. These FY 1973 and 1974 estimates are to be submitted in one copy each to the DDNRO, NRO Comptroller, and NRO Staff by not later than 28 April 1972.
- F. Cost estimates for FY 1975 thru 1978 are also necessary. It is realized that the same degree of estimating can not be developed for these years as for FY 73 and 74. Accordingly, magnitude estimates for each fiscal year against the following category headings will suffice.

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
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
