SUBJECT: FINAL REPORT ON POPPY PROGRAM

It appears that POPPY is destined to be abandoned on 30 September since Congress is apparently not going to approve funding for further operations. I recommend that the Program Office be tasked to prepare a "FINAL REPORT" on the POPPY Program once we abandon 7107. CLW

I would envision a somewhat comprehensive, but not highly technical, report that would identify and discuss:

- The POPPY Program as a whole
- Program Costs/Contractors
- Program Objectives
- Launch dates, Mission Termination dates, & other milestones
- Problems/anomalies encountered and their impacts on the mission
- Significant intelligence contributions and general overview of mission success (would probably require NSA input)
- Significant Non-achievements (ie where did the system not meet expectations, if any)
- Lessons learned

Such a report would admittedly be a rather large effort, however for historical purposes, especially since 7107 is the last of the POPPY series, I think it would be appropriate if such a report were prepared as it would give us an indication and measure of our success.

I would further suggest that a similar report be prepared and all of the NRO systems as they are terminated.

If you think such a report would be worthwhile we could informally query the Program Office as to the cost/manpower impact, how they would handle such a task, etc and get the staff's reaction. Based on the feedback we get we could make a decision of whether or not to approach the front office with the idea or kill it ourselves.
