(S//TK) The National Reconnaissance Office ceased operations of FARRAH-2 (Mission 7347) on 6 October 2004. After coordination with the Intelligence Community, I directed the decommissioning of the FARRAH-2 Signals Intelligence spacecraft from mission operations due to its degraded state of health and low data output. This spacecraft far outperformed the planned mean mission duration of 2.5 years, providing 20 years of intelligence data. FARRAH-2 was placed in a non-recoverable state and will remain on orbit in excess of 50 years.
