SUBJECT: Draft NRO Message re TOPHAT Operations

1. The proposed guidelines for access for TOPHAT personnel as set forth in paragraph three of reference are satisfactory to NSA.

2. Personnel not granted access but cleared for TK/E (paragraph 4, applies) need not be cleared for SI as long as the communications nature of the signal is not disclosed. If the communications nature of the signal is disclosed, an SI clearance is required. Information that the U.S. intercepts should carry a minimum classification or SECRET HVCCO.

3. Precedent for the above was set several years ago when parametric data on certain signals were released by NSA to CNO at the SECRET non-codeword level for contractor use.
