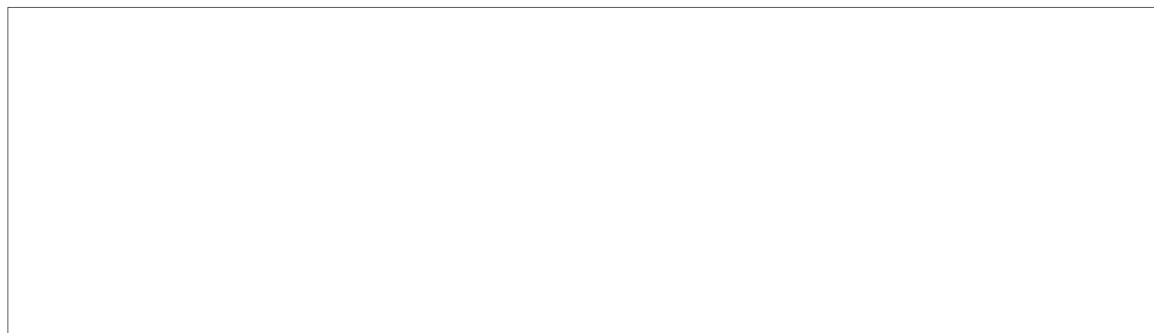

SUBJECT: Special Mission Guidance in Support of SIOP-5

REFERENCE: SORS 10./122/33, TCS-4015-73, dated 18 May 73

The SIGINT OVERHEAD RECONNAISSANCE SUBCOMMITTEE (SORS) recommends the following special mission guidance to support SIOP-5 planning and execution:

- I. Collection Guidance - Target Areas in Priority Groups are attached.



- II. Missions 7338/7342

Missions 7338/7342 should be tasked only against Priority Group II and Priority Group III target areas. Collection of Priority Group I target areas should be conducted when they are accessed simultaneously during any other collection task.

C. Mission 7341

Mission 7341 should collect in the 12.000-18.000 MHz range for [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. Mission 7341 should also collect against emitters associated with [REDACTED] when tasked in these specific frequencies and over locations during routine collection against PEG requirements.

D. Priority Group I target areas require access at least once each 24 hours, Priority Group II areas require access each 48 hours and Priority Group III areas should be covered once each 10 days. Since Mission 7341 cannot meet the frequencies of access specified for Priority I and Priority II target areas without considerable impact on current collection, collection by Mission 7341 against all target areas should be accomplished once each 10 days.

E. TARGET EMITTERS. All emitters associated with the [REDACTED] designated by temporary ELINT notations.

F. Accurate geopositioning of the target threat emitters is essential. A location accuracy of each emitter within [REDACTED] N.M. is desirable; however, less precise locations should be reported.

II. Processing and Reporting

Processing and reporting of all intercept data from the priority group areas in the attachment should be accomplished on an expeditious basis.

III. The SORS will review results of the above recommended collection as appraised by the Strategic Air Command and will further evaluate all intelligence gains and losses resulting from implementation of this mission guidance at the end of 60 days and will provide further guidance shortly thereafter.





TARGET AREAS




