Last month, identical letters were sent to the Department of the Army, Department of the Navy, National Security Agency and the Central Intelligence Agency to determine specific distribution requirements for SAMOS products.

A copy of the letters and the replies are attached so you can have the information before your 18 July meeting. The reply from the Department of the Navy has not been received.

The requirements, as expressed, will be satisfied. I think they exhibit the real need of the Intelligence agencies for photography with any usable resolution and all usable ferret data as well as confidence in Air Force capabilities.

Reconnaissance Data from SAMOS RAD

- 1. The first SAMOS launch is now scheduled in September 1980. If R&D objectives are met, a limited amount of reconnaissance data will be recorded on film and magnetic tape. The photographic image to be recorded on 35mm positive film can be reproduced, without titling, or reassembled on 9½ inch film and titled before distribution. The Elint Data recorded on magnetic tape must be calibrated prior to distribution. The signals will be in digital form and may be distributed on IEM tape or cards.
- 2. As an interim measure, in order to make use of the data collected by the RAD flights, the Air Force is preparing to reproduce and distribute to Intelligence Organizations all usable photographic images on 9½ inch roll film and all usable Elint Signals on IBM tape and cards.
- 3. The Intelligence Collection Requirements for a SAMOS Operational System are being reconsidered by the Satellite Intelligence Requirements Committee. However, if you desire to be placed on distribution for any of the above, which may become available from the RAD flights, request you designate your recipient and point of contact for appropriate detailed planning.

Recommaissance Data from BANOS RaD

- 1. With reference to your letter of 14 June 1960 on this subject, CTA has the following requirements for materials and facilities to permit us to exploit reconnaissance data from the SAMOS system during the initial phase of the SAMOS RAD flight program:
 - a. Two positions at the MANOS Data Processing Center for personnel to be trained and participate in the exploitation of SANOS photography with working space for as many as two additional persons who might need to work at the Data Processing Center, from time to time.
 - b. One direct positive or negative of the 35mm photographic recording of the readout of the data link between the satellite and earth, whichever is the product of the data link. If a choice is possible, we would prefer a positive.
 - c. One positive transparency and one duplicate negative of the reassembled pressty record.
 - d. One complete was of manuals on the procedures for handling the photography i.e. determining longitude, latitude, time, scale, etc., at the primary record as well as the reassembled materials.
 - e. A complete index of coverage on the ground by each pass denoting longitude. Letitude, time plas tilt, tip, swing, and altitude, calibrate and length and precise scale factor. It is assumed the BANNE Processing Center is equipped to handle the sphemeris records of the satellite in such a manner that these data can be provided in either machine tape or human language form.

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- 1. One copy of the preliminary readout which is done at the SANOS Processing Center in the form of an IPIR and other special alerts.
- g. If, at some later date, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Center is provided with center format data handling equipment, we will require center format photography as well as the 9" wide material. We will also require duplicate copies of all reference material which has been reduced to center format at the EANOS Processing Center.
- h. One diplicate positive and one duplicate negative of the highest possible quality will be required from the E-5 system as well as calibrated focal length and lens distortion pattern for the camera used.
- i. In the initial phases while the ELIMI data are produced in digital form, CIA will depend on reports of ELIMI results from the Mational Security Agency. Once the data are produced in analog form we will require duplicates of selected analog testords.
- 2, As additional information and experience is acquired conserning the SAMOS system, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Center will smend the requirements for photographic materials as needed. The SIA Office of Scientific Intelligence will also smend the requirements for ELIST data.
