The SIGINT OVERHEAD RECONNAISSANCE SUBCOMMITTEE (SORS) recommends the following special mission guidance for POPPY - Mission [redacted] STRAWMAN 4 - Missions 7167/7236/7240 and URSALA 1 - Mission 7338:

1. Provide coverage of Soviet shipborne emitters in the Sea of Japan area for Time Critical Reporting (TCR) during the period 7 December 1972 through 30 January 1973. Desired area of coverage is bounded by:

- 44°N/135°E
- 44°N/104°E
- 48°N/140°E
- 48°N/142°E
