5. CORONA - ARGON PROGRESS REPORT - It was reported that the last shot failed due to weight considerations. Studies are now being made to correct this. It is expected that a new, lighter fuel, now under development, will reduce the weight. Shot number 6 is scheduled for 15 July and number 7 for the first week in August. Both are payload shots. Lockheed has proposed a destructo mechanism which will weigh 30 pounds. General Electric has a limited destructo, weighing 9 pounds. The consensus appears to be that in view of the weight problem already existing, we should live with the small risk (.0016 of payload falling in denied territory).
