1. The reference message reported the planned travel of the Resident Office staff for the period 24 April thru 5 May 1967. This memorandum will focus attention on the activity of the staff for the period 17 to 21 April 1967.

2. Activity for the week of 17 April 1967.  
Monday - 17 April

A Staff Meeting was held. Following were the main subjects discussed:

1. The plans for the Readiness Review on 18 April.
2. The EKIT flights at [REDACTED] on 17-19 April.
3. The thrust cone modifications required by [REDACTED]. These are minor modifications involving a bracket for the IFD disconnect and the new hooks (serrated) for the guillotine.
4. The status of the DISIC buy-off and the remaining problem of the tilt axis shift of the DISIC stellar lens.
5. The review of the system data book.

Normal operations preparatory to the Readiness Review and the Managers' Meeting were conducted.

Tuesday - 18 April

The J-3 Payload Readiness Review was conducted. A separate TWX has been submitted on this and the review packages from each of the associate contractors had been forwarded to [REDACTED].

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Wednesday - 19 April

A Program Managers' Meeting was held. A separate report is being submitted on this meeting which covered problems in the J-3 Program.

Numerous other meetings were held with other attendees of the Readiness Meeting. Principle among these was a meeting among SOC personnel, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] regarding SOC/AP J-3 operational matters.

Thursday - 20 April

Preparations continued for the conduct of the Career Trainee group at [REDACTED] on 24 to 28 April. In addition, data continued to be gathered and analyzed relative to possible reasons for the "last three Corona flights being worse than previous Corona Missions." A review of the Readiness Meeting and the Program Managers' Meeting was conducted.

Friday - 21 April

Normal operations were conducted, principally in preparation for the Career Trainee visit and the analysis of previous Corona Missions.

3. Future activities and comments.

1. Career Trainee group at AP during the week of 24-28 April.
  2. [REDACTED] to be at AP the morning of 24 April for orientation tour.
  3. In view of the need for additional film in the event that 3404 type film would continue to be used on the Corona Program (in case UTB does not work out), the need to conserve film and the need to handle a catastrophic in one instrument, we are planning on proceeding with an analysis and design leading up to a design review of the PIBS Proposal by AP. This will be discussed with [REDACTED] on his visit next week.
