1. The reference TWX reported the planned travel of the Resident Office Staff period 22 May thru 2 June 1967. This report will focus attention on the activity of the Staff the period 15 to 19 May 1967.
2. Activities for the week of 15 May 1967.

Monday - 15 May

1. The Staff conducted normal operations. Much effort was put in by all members relative to determining the cause of the 400 cycle distortion and possible overload situation. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] spent the day at AP for payload orientation and plant tour. Bucket 1041 A was successfully retrieved.

Tuesday - 16 May

1. The Resident Office Staff conducted normal operations and continued to analyze the cause of the 400 cycle wave distortion.

Wednesday - 17 May

Program Manager's Meeting held. A separate report will be promulgated on this subject. Mission 1041 continues. Resident Office Staff conducted normal operations.

Thursday - 18 May

This day was spent in several discussions with the Contracting Officers of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at all discussions. The purpose of these meetings were to achieve an understanding on the part of the government as to the proposals

that [redacted] and [redacted] had submitted. It is felt that much of value was gained from these discussions. EKIT Tests 11A and 11B were successfully flown at [redacted].

Friday - 19 May

Further discussions were conducted with [redacted] of [redacted] and Madden and [redacted] of [redacted] relative to management of the program and specifically with [redacted] and Madden regarding the 400 cycle problem now under investigation.

The Resident Office conducted normal operations. [redacted] received a briefing from [redacted] and [redacted] of [redacted] staff relative to the vulnerability study they had accomplished for [redacted] program.

Mission 1041 continues.

3. Comments and Future Activities

[redacted] reported that all of the ETV Qual Tests and IFD Qual Tests have been completed. They appeared to be successful. The data is now being reduced and a final report will be submitted.

The status of CR-1 acceptance for a July flight will be continued to be highlighted by:

1. Concentrating on QR-2 and CR-1 reports during future Manager's Meetings.
2. Conducting CPX's on the J-1 Missions. As you know a preliminary CPX was run on Mission 1040, another on 1041 and another is planned for Mission 1042.
3. Conducting a "Final" evaluation of the readiness of CR-1 for launch at the July Manager's Meeting. A firm date has not been established at this time.
