



SUBJ: FLIGHT FILM ANOMALY.

1. DURING FLIGHT FILM LOADING OPERATIONS IN SUPPORT OF MISSION 1041 IT WAS OBSERVED THAT THE FILM WRAPS OF BOTH SPOOLS 24T AND 13B WERE STUCK TOGETHER PRINCIPALLY ALONG ONE FILM EDGE. THE OUTER 7 WRAPS WERE REMOVED FROM EACH SPOOL.

2. SPOOLS 24T AND 13B ARE BEING RETURNED TO [REDACTED] IN BOX 50 FOR YOUR INSPECTION. THE OUTER 7 WRAPS FROM EACH SPOOL ARE ALSO BEING RETURNED AND ARE CONTAINED IN A SEPARATE SMALL FILM CAN.

3. [REDACTED] RETAINED APPROXIMATELY 18 INCHES OF FILM FROM EACH SPOOL. [REDACTED] FILM SAMPLES SHOW AREAS IN THE FILM WHERE BONDING BETWEEN WRAPS OCCURRED. IN SEVERAL BONDED AREAS ALONG THE FILM EDGE THE EMULSION TRANSFERRED TO THE BACKING SURFACE OF THE ADJACENT FILM WRAP.

4. FILM ON SPOOLS 24T AND 13B IS FROM [REDACTED] FILM BATCH NUMBER 275-7/54-1-7.
