B. ALL MATERIAL OF THE FWD LOOKING CAMERA AFTER PASS 220D, FRAME 120 IS SERIOUSLY DEGRADED. AT THIS POINT THE FILM APPEARS TO HAVE COME OUT OF THE RAILS.

THE IMAGERY AND FIDUCIALS OF THE PORT LOOKING HORIZON CAMERA ARE GROSSLY SMEARED. APPROXIMATELY ONE HALF OF EVERY MAIN CAMERA FRAME FROM THE CENTER TO THE SUPPLY END IS ALSO GROSSLY SMEARED. OTHER DEGRADATIONS IN THE FORM OF HEAVY EMULSION SCRATCHES, CREASES, AND EMULSION GOUGES ARE PRESENT. BOTH EDGES OF THE FILM ARE FOGGED FROM THE HOLEY RAIL LIGHT SOURCE. THE BINARY TIME WORD IS MISSING THROUGHOUT THIS MATERIAL. THERE ARE ALSO INSTANCES OF MISMETERING AND MISTRACKING.

THIS ANOMALY OCCURRED AT APPROXIMATELY 203 FEET FROM THE END CUT WHICH WAS MADE IN PASS 230D, FRAME 13. A MANUFACTURING SPLICE IS

PRESENT IN FRAME #01 OF PASS 228D WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 517 FEET FROM THE END CUT. THIS ANOMALY DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE ASSOCIATED WITH THIS MANUFACTURING SPLICE. THE TOTAL PROCESSED FOOTAGE OF THE FORWARD LOOKING CAMERA RECORD WAS 6,737 FEET.
