

1 April 1971 through 30 June 1971

I. CORONA PROGRAM

CR-14 (Mission 1114) Performance Evaluation Team (PET) meeting was held at NPIC on 20-21 April 1971, with all team members in attendance. The Performance Interim Evaluation Report (PIER) stating excellent performance was issued by the team based on the MIP ratings assigned earlier. The report indicated a trouble-free mission.

CR-15 remained in a backup condition throughout Mission 1114 and then was recycled to prepare for a tentative launch 16 June 1971 (Mission 1115). Launch preparations were completed and the system counted down to R-7 at which time the decision was made to revert to a R-15 backup status for the [REDACTED] Program launch. The system is now at R-25 status, and will remain in this configuration until a decision is made relative to establishing a flight schedule for the three remaining CORONA systems.
