As a result of our recent conversations with Dr. Land, I believe we should consider what actions we should take now leading toward development of a read-out system.

Accordingly, I propose that we prepare by July 15 a paper for EXCOM consideration that addresses:

- l. the value of or near real-time read-out for . indications, warning, crises, and day-to-day intelligence production;
- 2. the relative contribution to these intelligence needs of alternative performance in terms of area coverage, target frequency and resolution:
- 3. the status of technology and the effect of potential developments on our ability to provide alternative systems with near realtime read-out; and,

4. the value and cost of alternative read-out systems and their effect on the total mix of satellite photography.

I have asked of my staff to take the lead in preparation of such a paper working with the NRO, CIA and DoD staffs.

in the meantime, we have added \$1.95M in FY 69 funds to the CIA echnology program.
