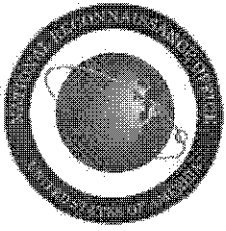

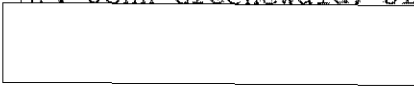

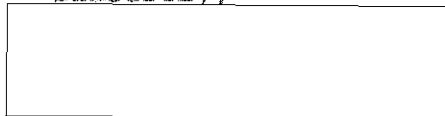
We have accepted your request. It will be processed in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended.

It would seem more reasonable, however, to allow us sufficient time to continue processing your request and respond as soon as we can. Unless we hear from you otherwise, we will assume that you agree and will continue processing your FOIA request on this basis. You will have the right to appeal any denial of records after you receive a final response to your request.

The FOIA authorizes federal agencies to assess fees for record services. Based upon the information provided, you have been placed in the "educational/scientific/media" category of requesters, which means you are responsible for duplication fees (\$.15 per page) exceeding 100 pages.
