Consequently, redactors in the IART declassification unit apply this literally and, in their review of records, redact any mention that space and ground systems are vulnerable to attack or deception. The fact that space systems are vulnerable to attack and deception, as you know, is acknowledged in public records already released, and I think we would be unable to defend this kind of generic redaction if it is appealed to the Interagency Security Classification Appeals Panel (ISCAP).

"Redact: all information that identifies <u>specific</u> vulnerabilities of satellite ground and space systems, deception and denial countermeasures to which space systems are susceptible, and defensive countermeasures taken to minimize damage to space systems."

This, or similar wording, would help us avoid the kind of unthinking redactions that have been applied previously.

Let me know if you concur, and, if so, the preferred wording that should be used.
