 - o The colors were selected to synchronize with the NRO Style Guide the darkest blue in the logo matches NRO Blue, the gold matches the NRO Orbit Gold, and the red dot matches the NRO Red.
- What does the name mean?
 - o CSPO is the official name of the new GEOINT office that was stood up in Spring 2018 to procure commercial imagery.
- Any objects have any significance?
 - o The red dot on the right-hand side of the globe represents a satellite orbiting the earth.
 - o The squares lifting off the globe are meant to represent pixels (imagery) being collected from the earth.
