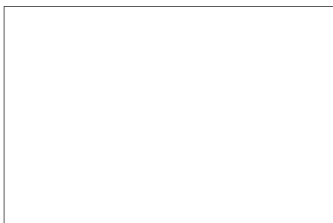

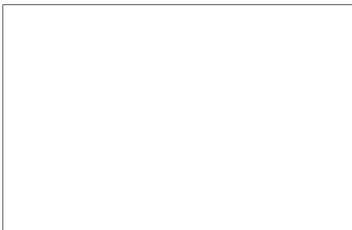

Subject: Photon DC Trip

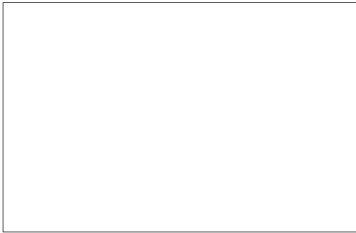
