The attachment referenced is the Packard memorandum establishing the Benington study. The time scale of that study is sometime in July, consistent with the proposed ExCom meeting.

CIA is quite unhappy with the turn of events and feels that Mr. Packard's statement, 'Until we have decided on whether to proceed with a new system, ... " is at variance with his earlier "decision."

The Benington study is underway and should provide perspective, but the controversy exists.
