Now that the decision has been made to go ahead with the EOI system, we must decide upon a site for the ground facilities and initiate acquisition and construction actions. Over the past several months, we have considered a number of possible locations from the standpoint of electromagnetic environment, community impact, ease of cover, and, most important, reasonable proximity to the analytic resources of the DOD and CIA.
