SUBJECT: DCI Briefing to the President

Dr. Cook was informed yesterday that Admiral Turner plans to brief the President on intelligence collection. As an input to that briefing he would like the NRO to prepare a 10 minute presentation on the capabilities and limitations of our imagery systems. This briefing should include the management of imagery, i.e., response to and satisfaction of requirements and flexibility of the systems. Under capabilities the briefing should include resolution and different coverage modes. In the limitations area, we should stress
