
Dr. Teller took an active part in the discussion. He said at the outset that he preferred not to see any charts; however, by the end of the briefing he had looked at one or two charts on organization and all of the pictorial system charts. Dr. Teller expressed the following views:

- a. The U-2 program should be continued and, if anything, emphasized. We should consider arming the U-2s with laser weapons for use against laser-equipped interceptors which Dr. Teller believes will appear within two years.
- b. We should use color film with existing systems and emphasize the need for color imagery in planned systems.
- c. We should be developing an all-weather day-andnight photographic system using pulsed lasers.
- d. We should give serious consideration to multiple decoy satellites which would convince the Russians that they are under constant observation.
- e. We should consider the use of nuclear power supplies for our long life vehicles, instead of solar arrays.


