MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: NSAM 311 - KH-4, KH-6 [REDACTED] Coverage of Cuba

The attached papers were prepared on 8-11 January at Mr. Friedman's request. The KH-6 material presented a problem, since I had no indication regarding Dr. McMillan's feelings on the possibility of re-opening the KH-6 payload production line.

I was unable to see Dr. McMillan on 11 January to clear the paper with him. Mr. Friedman asked for a copy on the evening of 11 January and I gave it to him with a cautionary note that it was a working draft, had not been cleared with Dr. McMillan, and should be held carefully until cleared.

On 12 January I briefed Dr. McMillan on the matter. He seemed to have no objection to considering KH-6 production, but stated emphatically that he would have to see Mr. Vance on the matter. I was to advise Mr. Friedman that this meeting would take place "before the day is out" (11 January). I did so.

Later on 11 January, Mr. Friedman indicated that a conversation with Mr. McNaughton had brought out some caveat on disclosing KH-6.
