Dear Brock:

I note in your memorandum of 30 December 1963 concerning the NRO FY 65 budget estimate (94-63) that there is a statement on page six concerning funding for synchronous satellites. That statement, if I understand correctly, indicates that it appears to be your intention to assign to the Director, Program A, NRO, in FY 65 responsibility for any new system development in this particular satellite field.

Developmental work on [redacted] is a responsibility assigned to the Director, Program A, NRO, and it is my position that that responsibility should remain unchanged. I therefore wish to call my position in this matter to your attention, as this position will be sustained at such time as further discussions take place on programming NRO activities for FY 65.
