MEMORANDEM FOR DR. FLAX

SUBJECT: Discussion with Admiral Boone re Sep 12 MEFFC Meeting

Admiral Boone had some suggested changes to the August 20 paper you sent Dr. Seamens on "DOD-MASA Coordination of the Earth Resources Survey Program." Admiral Boone hoped to secure your concurrence in these medifications prior to the Sept 12 meeting.

The specific changes proposed by Admiral Boone, keyed to your Aug 20 paper (Tab C, attached folder), plus my comments to him about them are as follows:

- 1. Page 1. Section 1. General Objective: Add the following statement: "(See Report of MEAN 156 Ad Noc Committee, dated July 11, 1966. TOP SECRET Committee). I did not feel there would be any objections to the second of the committee.
- 2. <u>Page 3. Section 3. Control Measures</u>: Add the following to the last paragraph of Section 3: "(The MAM 156 Ad Hoc Committee will remain available for consultation concerning possible political or security issues which might arise.)" I did not feel there would be any particular objection to this addition.
- 3. Page 3. Section 5. Functions of the MSFFC Related to MSESP: Insert the following new paragraph b and renumber the old 5.b and 5c accordingly: "When the requirement for improved sensor capabilities in the MERSP has been established by a user agency, and as the known state-of-the-art advances and sensors of improved performances become operational in the MEP, review the limiting criteria governing the use of sensors in the MERSP and, if appropriate, make suitable recommendations to move the prescribed threshold of performance toward more precise ground resolutions.".....I indicated some concean over the words but felt the intent was reasonable.

4. Page 7. Section 7. Specific Guidelines. Criteria, and Ground Pules for the Gundust of Histr: Add the following new paragraph 7f on page 7 and remarker old 7f through 71 accordingly: "Regular review of HEP data will be made by representatives of SACC for purpose of: (1) determining if detailed analyses should be made by cleared HASA personnel as a guide for HERSP planning; and/or (2) recommending to HERSP that the Director of Control Intelligence be requested to reclassify or declassify those data applicable to HERSP.".....Although I did not indicate any particular concern over this paragraph at the time Admiral Booms and I discussed it, upon further reflection, it seems at least partially redundant with the present para 7g. Further, the words "HEP data" in the proposed 7f need clarification and part (2) regarding the BCI and classification moods clarification if it is to remain therein. Probably, the intent is acceptable.

If you have any thoughts on these proposed changes prior to the MEFFC meeting, please edvise and I will relay them to Admiral Boone.
