



SUBJECT: House Armed Services Committee Testimony

I talked with Dr. Hall this morning with regard to a possible Hearing. He was aware of our newest information that Slatinshek desires a Colby/Hall presentation to include some NRO information. Hall is working with Colby to outline a 1-1/2 hour presentation consisting of an opening statement by Colby, a CIA presentation - possibly by Clarke - and an ASD(I) presentation by Hall. They currently plan no NRO presentation, but Hall requests that I go with him for questions.

As in many such presentations, all of this is subject to change so stay loose - but prepared.

New subject - Hall was not aware of earlier contact with Slatinshek and required that has fice be advised of all such contacts by our NRO people.

I have had word from two sources this morning that there will be a budget meeting with the Medsi Subcommittee of the House Armed Services Committee on Monday, I April.
