


SUBJECT: Eaton Committee Final Report

Last week you passed to me a copy of the Eaton Committee final report (which you had received from Mr. Bross) marked for "Mr. Reber and General Berg -- Eyes Only." You indicated that for the present it should be held discreet and that Mr. Reber and General Berg should discuss the report with you. This copy is in General Berg's hands.

I have just received an official transmission of the report from Mr. Nitze, who asked your comments on the Eaton Committee report by November 15. Mr. Nitze plans to respond to the DCI's request with copies of the comments of appropriate elements of the DOD.
