SUBJECT: Personal Memorandum

TO: RDG (General Schriever)

The following three items I would like to bring to your attention:

1. You have received a brief letter from General Walsh confirming the requirement for 5 ft ground resolution for photographic sensors in satellite systems. We are passing this information on to BMD and would be happy to show you the letter if you desire.
2. As a follow-up on the special systems which Mr. Bissell discussed with you a couple of weeks ago and for which I made the trip to the west coast last week, a meeting to review technical features of the systems prior to a final decision is being held at Dr. Charyk's office at 1400 on 20 August.
