

MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF DEFENSE (INTELLIGENCE)

SUBJECT: Senate Select Committee Input

In response to your memorandum of 17 July, 666151-75), I also appreciate the need to maintain a carefully consistent position in providing data to the Senate Select Committee.

As you know, Tom Latimer has secured a special arrangement for the NRO's relationship with the Committee. Under this arrangement substantive NRO data will not normally be forwarded to the Committee but will be consolidated for the Quanbeck Task Force's review in my staff office. That Task Force only has been authorized unlimited access to material determined to be germane to the investigation. A similar arrangement is in the process of being extended to the House Investigation Committee.

I believe that the present arrangements are very useful and should be continued. I will also assure that my staff continues to coordinate with your office on matters relating to NRO inputs to the Committee.
