

MEMORANDUM FOR DEPUTY SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

SUBJECT: Waiver of Department of Defense (DOD) Directives  
and Instructions

You will recall that on May 3, 1972 you directed implementation of the Satellite Data System (SDS) Management Plan. In your May 3, 1972 memo, you recognized that there was a need to waive certain DOD Directives and Instructions which conflict with the SDS Management Plan. Several of these have now been identified and require your waiver approval to effect the necessary security requirements and to implement streamlined management procedures.

SUBJECT: Waiver of Department of Defense (DOD) Directives

c. Department of Defense Instruction Number 7041.2, "Cost Information Reports (CIR)," June 13, 1966.
