
The program objectives and related funding for the
DISCOVERER program as presented to ARPA February 4, 1957,
and, in general, approved.

It is particularly noted that this approval pertains to the
13 vehicle program.

Accordingly, ARPA Order No. 48-59, dated December 16,
1958, is hereby amended to make available \$104,800,000 under
appropriation and account symbol "97X0113.002 Salaries and Ex-
penses, Advanced Research Projects Agency, Department of
Defense."

The decrease of \$1,700,000 in the amount authorized from
the \$106,500,000 requested in the Development Plan has been ex-
plained to your staff.

The Development and Funding Plan, dated January 30, 1959,
pertaining to the DISCOVERER program, is being reviewed and
specific comments relating thereto will be provided for further
program guidance.
