Discoverer Re-Entry Studies

At the time of writing this memo, the undersigned and Colonel Evans, together with Colonel Cody and Lockheed, had just reviewed the results of the Discoverer 5 launch. We have mutually agreed upon actions taken to date, which we hope will provide with a successful Discoverer 6 flight. In addition to these actions, I feel one additional study is required. This study would be a detailed review of all conditions affecting re-entry and would be similar to the close look we (the undersigned and Col Dodge) took at the GE capsule and nose cone recovery program early this year-- prior to the time we began to successfully recover nose cones. In view of the large number of flights scheduled for the Discoverer series, I feel this type of background is necessary to prevent possible additional trouble in this area.
