## MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS

SUBJECT: Ship support for DISCOVERER Program

Reference your message 20708, 13 February 1959 expressing concern over the unresolved problem of providing necessary ship support for the DISCOVERER Program.

The problem is now resolved to the extent that the Bureau of Acronautics has now been authorized to proceed with the medification of two VC-2 ships. \$1.6 million has been provided for initiation of work with a total authorization not to exceed \$2.3 million of ARPA funds to be provided after receipt and approval of a development and funding plan.

Based upon earlier estimates of five menths lead time for conversion, it may be late July or early August before beneficial availability of these ships. Hopefully, some reduction in this conversion time may be possible. In the event this is not possible I would approxiate your consideration of an extension of the destroyer support beyond 7 July, as necessary, to support the firing schedule.

I recognize the undesirability of use of combetant forces for R&D support but hope that other commitments will not preclude such support for the relatively short time period involved.
