I, therefore, recommend that the decision to have ARPA pay for the Point Arguello Launcher and the Vandenberg Missile Assembly Building be reversed and that the Air Force, instead of the ARPA, provide the construction funds for these facilities. This proposed transfer of funds between the Air Force and the ARPA will not affect the overall DISCOVERER/SENTRY Program funding of \$215 millions in Fiscal Year 1979.
