1. Letter to Air Staff and Major Commands concerning correspondence direct with WDD signed and dispatched. Essentially, this letter asked that the Air Staff and Major Commands correspond directly with WDD on all matters not requiring the personal attention of General Power or General Seassum with an information copy to ARDC. Information copies of correspondence concerning command policy or requiring the personal attention of General Power or General Seassum would be sent to WDD thereby permitting concurrent action by WDD and ARDC.
2. Prepared comments on a program for conducting "Ocean Gravitational Surveys" proposed by the Navy to provide capability for acquisition of gravimetric data. WDD comments were included. Comments were handcarried to AFCCM in order to meet established deadline.
3. As advised by Mr. Yeager, RDIF, that the New York Development Field Office did not have sufficient TDY funds to finance Lt Colonel DeGennaro's trip to WDD this month for indoctrination on his duties. ~~Advised Lt Colonel Hamilton, WDS, of this situation and suggested that WDD cite funds for the TDY to the New York AFIFO if it were agreeable that WDD would fund the trip.~~
4. Showed two films to General Power and staff on the WDD activities. One film concerned 1st Quarter CY 56 ICBM/IREM progress and highlighted facilities, and the second concerned the Ballistic Missiles Office, AMC (WDD).
5. Received call from Major Stokes, WDO, concerning plans for the 16 June briefing of General Power and staff on the ICBM IOC. Arrangements made for transportation, hotel reservation, storage of charts, presentation room, and security to include access to Sun Building on Friday night, 15 June, and Saturday, 16 June 1956.
6. Sixth monthly progress report prepared for General Power's signature and forwarded to USAF.
7. RDS advised RDGB by DF that the Comptroller (RDSC) will be responsible for developing the format and consolidating the allied support requirements (P-200 and P-690 fund areas) for the WS 107A and WS 315A.

8. Received call from Lt Colonel J. E. Child advising that he and Major Combs would attend the briefing on Saturday. Made reservations for them and arranged for storing briefing charts.

9. Final arrangements were completed for and the presentation on ICBM/IREM IOC held for General Power and key ARDC staff officers on 16 June 1956.

10. General Power advised that he had received agreement from the Assistant Secretaries of the Air Force to cancel the proposed P-600 vs P-151 audit. General Schriever and Colonel Lodell were advised.

11. General Power was directed to appear before the Symington Committee on 20 June along with General Schriever. General Schriever and Colonel Ritland were advised. Information was subsequently furnished to Colonel Carpenter, RDGPL, in support of the presentation.

12. A summary of the status of action in Hq USAF on WS 117L was furnished General Schriever including the information that Dr. Furnas had requested General Putt to have the Air Force (WDD) present a briefing on WS 117L to the ODM Science Advisory Committee.

13. Lt Colonel Oder was on TDY at WDD 10-13 June.
