1. There are no arguments, additions or deletions we would propose to your Statement of Work, "Study of Guidance Facilities".
2. The WS 117L will plan to use the WS 107 (less nose cone) without modification during the first phase; therefore, the criteria, specifications, cost, etc., for the guidance facilities will probably be the same as WS 107 with the exception of the geographical orientation.
3. In addition, the WS 117L system will have a requirement for detection and tracking stations as described in the WS 117L Development Plan. It is suggested that it may be desirable for your contractor, which will be selected to do the work described in this Statement of Work, to perform the same type of study for the detection and tracking stations.
4. As soon as the "type" of equipment to be incorporated in these stations is determined, it is suggested that the above proposal be considered.
