MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: MOL SIGINT Study Program

1. Dr. Flax, Harry Davis, General Stewart and I met at 0900 this date and discussed the SIGINT Study Program. It was agreed that the following course of action would be followed:

a. We should proceed with the SIGINT Pointing Study and the funding responsibility for that would be assigned to the MOL Program.

b. [REDACTED] would be carried on by the NRO with NRO funds. The data reduction effort connected therewith if it were unique to MOL would be funded by the MOL Program.

c. The aircraft test program would be carried on using MOL funds.

d. The management arrangements currently in effect for the DORIAN sensor would apply generally to the MOL SIGINT Program, i.e., General Martin's organization would be responsible for the technical work on the sensors; General Berg's office would be responsible for the overall SIGINT integration, schedules and funding [REDACTED].

2. Dr. Flax indicated that the results of all of these studies would be handled under NRO security procedures.

3. In later discussions with General Stewart, we tentatively agreed that a small SIGINT office should be established on the West Coast under SAFSP and under conditions similar to that established for Lt Colonel Knolle's sensor payload office and that these two offices would be kept separate at least for the time being.

4. Further provision will be made for inputs from the MOL office into the [REDACTED] devices are tailored insofar as possible to meet study requirements of the MOL SIGINT Program.
