- 1. Your attention is invited to the attached copy of message SAFSL-8 23758, dated 21 Nov 66.
- 2. We regret that it was necessary to take this action through management channels. A scrutiny of employee recruitment advertising which has appeared during the past three months in both trade and other publications indicates General Electric was not sufficiently aware of the MOL information policy despite the fact that you were thoroughly briefed during your visit to Space Systems Division and despite the fact that Mr. Eugene Alberts, Chief of Security Review, Space Systems Division had personally discussed this with you at a later date.
- 3. Inasmuch as the contractor Director or Manager of Public Relations is the single point of contact for dissemination of instructions pertaining to the public release of information on classified Air Force contracts, it is incumbent upon that individual to see that instructions and policy guidance are disseminated to every branch of the company which has occasion to prepare and release information to the public. This includes, but is not restricted to product information, public relations, customer relations, marketing, sales, employee relations, employee publications, advertising, etc.
- 4. We believe the policy which pertains to release of information on the MOL program is explicit and should be easily understood by all concerned.
- 5. Request that you inform this office in writing as to what action has been taken within your company to insure that this policy is strictly adhered to.
